“Yenna yali ajoobaanye omusaayi nga toline w’omukwata. Nga tosobola kumanya oba ebiwundu biri ku magulu oba ku mikono, omumwa n’okutu byali bisigaddeko kalebwerebwe ,” Matovu bw’agamba.

E Kiwoko ku kitanda, Nalubira yamala wiiki bbiri nga tamanyi biri ku nsi. Omukono ogumu abasawo baagutemako, omulala ne bagussaamu ekyuma.

Bakulu ba ‘kalibutemu’ bwe baasusuumukamu ,omuwala ne yeefumbiza, omulenzi owokubiri n’ava awaka olwo ‘Katibutemu’ n’asigala yekka ne jjajjaawe. Abadde asoma Katuumu Islamic P/S e Katikamu mu p.6.
